


UPDATE ON THE SALE OF OUR BUILDING

A very Happy New year to you all. These are exciting times for Al Koran as we move forward in a positive manner into a wonderful new year. Many of you have been asking what is going on with the sale of the building. As you will be receiving this in January and considering that there is a bit of a lead time in getting the articles into the magazine, here is a summary of events as of December 5, 2014.

Earlier last year the building was listed for sale. In September of 2014 a prospective buyer approached the Divan with a proposal for purchase. From October until the beginning of November an informal series of negotiations took place resulting in an official offer of sale for the building and land located at 1000 East Edgerton Road in the City of Broadview Heights.

The Board of Directors of the Al Koran Holding Company have met 3 to 4 times each month since the beginning of October deliberating over the terms of the sale. The Nobles of the BOD of the Holding Company authorized the signing of a letter of intent to proceed with the sale of the building, under the conditions set forth under the rules, regulations, and bylaws of the Al Koran Holding Company, Al Koran Shriners, and Shriners International.

A letter to all Noble of Al Koran Shriners containing the following information was sent out twenty days prior to our regular business November meeting.

Pursuant to sections 334.9 and section 334.10 (e) of the bylaws of the Iowa Corporation, section 6.6 of the bylaws of Al Koran Shriners, and in conjunction with the bylaws of the Al Koran Holding Company, you are hereby notified that a meeting of the Al Koran Holding Company and the Al Koran Shriners will be held November 17, 2014, at 7 pm, at 1000 East Edgerton road in the City of Broadview Height, Ohio to discuss and vote on an offer, received by the Board of Directors of the Al Koran Holding Company, to sell the property and buildings located at 1000 East Edgerton Road in the City of Broadview Heights, Ohio. The details and conditions of this potential sale will be presented to the membership at this meeting. As Nobles of Al Koran Shrine Temple you are also members of the Al Koran Holding Company and are therefore entitled to participate and vote at this meeting.

While the presentation at the meeting included a considerable amount of financial information that has not been included in this article, the basic terms presented at that meeting were the purchase price of \$1.2 million and a lease on the present site for five years consisting of approximately 3,000 square feet of office space, preferred use of the Oasis and Ballroom for the *Continued next page*

needs of Al Koran Shriners and its Clubs and Units, at \$0.0 cost for rent, with Basic utilities also included at no cost. The following was then moved and seconded:

That the Property and Buildings located at 1000 East Edgerton Road, in the City of Broadview Heights, Ohio be sold to Club Motor Estates for a price of \$1.2 million, and that Al Koran Shrine center be furnished with approximately 2000 square feet of space for five years without rental costs and without utility costs.

Furthermore, that a lease agreement, be a part of the sales contract, delineating the rights and privileges that Al Koran Shriner's will be entitled to, be further negotiated by the Al Koran Holding Company Board of Directors with the Buyer. This Lease agreement shall be approved by no less than 9 of the 13 members of the Al Koran Holding Company Board of Directors. If a suitable lease agreement cannot be negotiated the sales contract will not be executed.

This motion was discussed and then voted on. There were 66 Nobles present for this meeting and with 49 voting in the affirmative and 16 in the negative.

At the time of this writing the BOD of the Holding Company has been diligently working on a Lease Agreement, and is actually in the final stages of completing the terms and conditions of the lease. Details contained in this lease will be available to the Nobility at a future business meeting.




