Volunteers/Drivers and PA Law 153 Update

From: Roger Neff, Erie Board of Governors and Chief Rabban

The Law in Pennsylvania that required all Al Koran "Drivers and Volunteers" to go through a criminal background check and fingerprinting has been revised by the State Legislature and moved on by the Governor. Following some 800,000 applications and almost as many complaints from Church groups, Boy/Girl Scout Organizations... and Shriners, they have modified the law.

Two modifications affect us at Al Koran and our continued ability to get our kids to SHC-Erie, Pittsburgh Children's Hospital and SHC- Philadelphia. Children 18 years of age or older and those younger being accompanied by a "parent/grandparent or guardian" need NOT be driven by a "Certified" volunteer driver. This would cover virtually every situation I believe we have with our Al Koran kids.

Those Drivers that have already applied for certification – Thank You. You will be noted for any special transport situation we might have that would require "Certified" drivers. The length of your Certification has also been extended from 3 years – to 5 years. They have also dropped the fee for the two background checks that were required. Fingerprinting will still have a fee attached that Al Koran will pay for through reimbursement with a receipt.

There will be more information shared with you as I have it.

The Houston Hospital is certainly a fantastic structure. Several kids were there with their parents as well. They have equipment similar to Erie to detect problems using electrodes and screens to diagnosis problems. Wonderful facility and hope you will all get to see it one day.

Wayne enjoyed the meetings and the group voted as instructed to. On our last night the "The Texas Tenors" entertained us. These three guys won first place on Americans Got Talent 6 years ago. They were terrific!

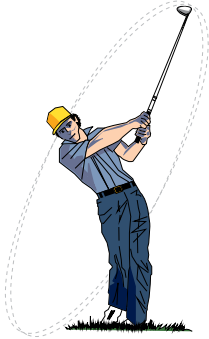
