

Greetings Nobles, summer has flown by and we are now preparing for fall and some outstanding colors appearing, making our landscape more beautiful and making us realize this could only happen thru the Great Creator, get out and enjoy the season. Fall is another time to prepare for winter and that dreaded word SNOW, make sure those snow throwers are working and you have enough melting salt, prepare your auto for those winter months with oil change, battery checks, wiper and fluid checks, you will be glad you did. Al Koran has been called back to labor and we are continuing to work for you the members who make up this great fraternity. We have moved into a new space within the building due to the sale of the property and although the transition has been difficult we are making the best of it.

Sunshine Chairman Emil Arvidson has informed me that the sick bay is empty and everyone is healthy. Keep up the good health!




