AL KORAN HOSPITAL DRIVERS ORIENTATION INFORMATION

Drivers are required to submit an insurance form to the Al Koran Recorder so they may be covered under the center insurance policy.

Then you will be added to the drivers list and contacted by a transportation coordinator who will arrange you being teamed with an experience driver on the first run you volunteer to accept. The experienced driver will explain how to get to the hospitals, registering in and out at the front desk, what we do while waiting for the patient, and once back at the van storage location being sure we fill the gas tank for the next run.

Physical contact with the patients is not necessary or encouraged. This is the responsibility of the family member traveling with the patient.

Our transportation coordinator will send each registered driver a list of patient hospital visits appointments detailing day and time of the appointments, the name of the patient, pick up time and location. Drivers volunteer for specific runs at their discretion and selection. Al Koran drivers normally transport patients to our Shrine Hospitals at Erie Pa. and Cincinnati Ohio.

Providing transportation for the children we serve is a tradition and a function of our philanthropy. Our drivers become a very real part of our service to help children enjoy a better life. As we continue to help with medical service without charging the family.


