## From the Recorder

Greetings Nobles, as of this writing The Winds of November have not reared up yet but I suspect they will be shortly. This message will arrive after Thanksgiving and I hope you all had plenty to eat and plenty of football to watch on T.V. Remember those less fortunate during our Holiday Season and especially our kids and their families, also remember our service people in harm's way every day, say a special prayer for them as well.

Dues statements for the 2017 year have once again been sent by Imperial in Tampa, I have received several calls of not receiving statements, Nobles please give me a call or just send your dues to the office to my attention and they will be posted as normal. The by-laws section 332.2 require all members to pay annually the amount set by the Temple which at Al Koran is \$137.00 which includes your per-capita amount to Imperial (\$30) and your hospital assessment (\$5) going to the hospital fund in Tampa.
