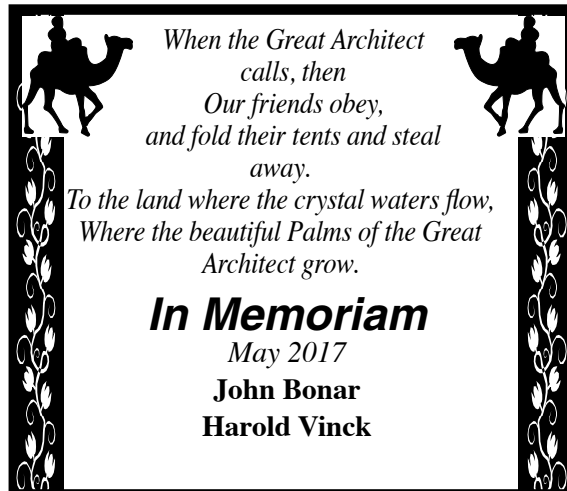

Greetings Nobles,
