
Transportation Unit

From the Recorder

Greetings Nobles,

As of this writing the weather outside is frightening with temperatures in single digits and wind chills even lower. Peg and I are preparing to get away from it all on the Grand Lodge of Ohio Cruise to Mexico and the Caribbean Islands, we will be sure to send back some warm temperatures. We hope all had a great holiday season and good times with family and friends. Our Installation of Officers is concluded and I congratulate all who were elected and appointed to serve Al Koran, I also would like to thank you Nobles for allowing me to serve as Recorder again in 2018, this is my fifth year and I have enjoyed every day especially meeting many Nobles who I did not know, Peg and I have been welcomed into many of the clubs and units when we attend and we will continue to attend as often as we can.

Nobles, there are still 200 or so who have not paid 2018 dues, if you are one of those please send payment NOW, you do not need your statement to pay your dues, they remain at \$137.00, you can send them to my attention in the office, please include your member number on check, if you wish to use credit card again call the office so we can get that info and process payment. The 2018 dues card stickers are being sent from Tampa and should be arriving to those who have paid their dues shortly, if you do not have a plastic card call me in the office and I can order a replacement, however we will need to charge for replacement cards. Al Koran does not have these cards; both these items were provided by Imperial to help all Shrine Centers save postage costs. There are 195 Shrine Centers in USA and over 300,000 members so it is a great effort to make sure the statements, cards and stickers are sent correctly and they rely on the Recorders to provide correct information. I have received several back via return mail which was sent to the address on file, if you have moved or are a snowbird, please inform me of your new address and also address of your winter months so communications are not lost, thank you in advance for complying.

As 2017 has concluded the annual reports were filed and some interesting facts about Al Koran. We started the 2017 year with 1086 regular members and 4 associate members for total of 1090 members. During 2017 we created 35, restored 13, affiliated 2 and had an associate join our ranks for total of 51, however we lost 36 to suspension (NPD or pre-req. body suspension), 5 to demit and 43 to death for total of 84, our membership as of December 31, 2017 is 1052 regular and 5 associates for total of 1057, our net loss was 33. Thanks to the hard work of our membership committee the net loss was better than previous years. Nobles please do your part to remain a member of Al Koran, if you are experiencing hardships please call the office and we will provide suggestions for dues payments, also be on the lookout for new members, petitions will be available on line. Requirements remain your potential member must be Master Mason in good standing and a resident of Ohio.

Please MAKE THE EFFORT to attend one meeting or event during 2018, you will be surprised of the changes, the officers have pledged to improve our meetings and events so come out and be part of the exciting 2018 Shrine year. Please call the office for all reservations. I look forward to working with all of you and the continuing challenges of this office.
