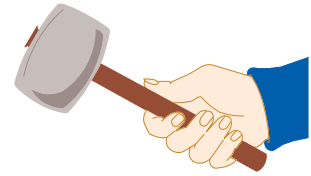

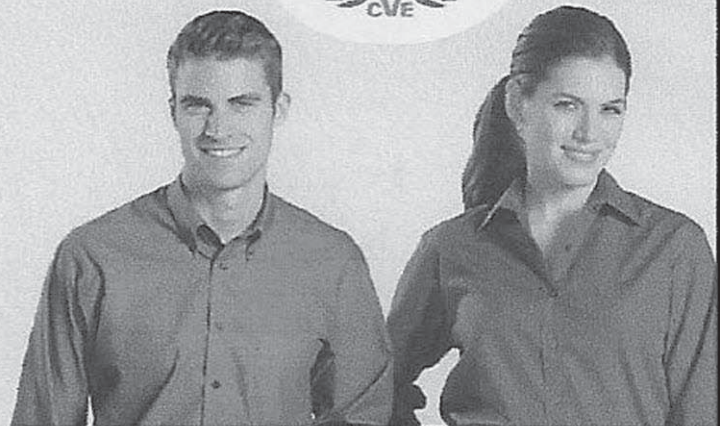

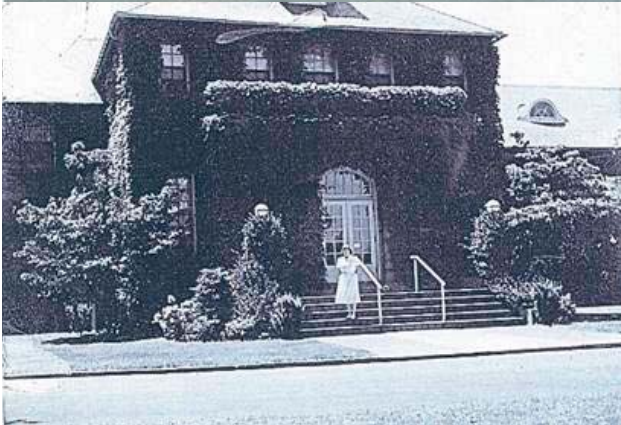

## Families treated to a special evening of *WONDER*

**Families, patients and staff from Shriners Hospitals for Children—Cincinnati were treated to an exclusive first look at the new film “Wonder” on Wednesday, November 15.**

The film tells the story of Auggie Pullman, a boy with facial differences from a genetic disorder that prevented him to attend mainstream school until his fifth grade year, and how that year changed him and everyone around him.

More than 100 guests, including patients and their families, staff members and other hospital stakeholders, attended the screening, which opens to the public on November 17. Guests received special movie mementos, including tee shirts and posters which depict the film’s message: “Choose kind”.

“Our families are very familiar with dealing with situations like



Auggie’s,” said hospital Director of Marketing Mashayla Colwell, whose department made the screening possible. “We wanted them to see this special film in a setting that would remind them that they are heroes, too.”
