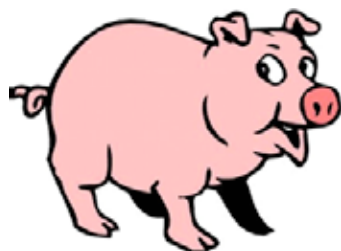

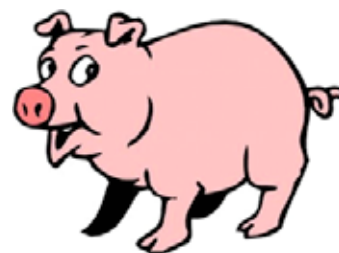

He is a dedicated advocate for physically challenged people and often speaks to various groups. He even ran for political office in Boardman Township during the recent primaries. Looks like William has a bright future ahead of him. I think the great doctors, Shriners and all the people who have helped him along the way should be very proud. This is why we do what we do!
