



Mariner's Log – Bob Stanley, M.S.A.

The day after the surrender of Germany on May 7, 1945, President and Noble Harry S. Truman requested the Missouri license plate number 5745 for his family vehicle. This license plate was issued to Brother Truman and was his until he passed away in 1972. It was then that the Missouri Bureau of Motor Vehicles retired license plate number 5745 - never to be issued again.
