



Greetings Nobles, as of this writing the days are growing shorter and somewhat cooler, Hurricane Florence is approaching the Carolina coast and will wreak havoc along its' route, please keep those residents in your prayers as they leave home or decide to ride out this dangerous storm. We are preparing for our annual Sportsman Raffle and hope all attendees had a great time. The Grand bodies will be meeting this month and some decisions made may affect our Shrine, please get to your Lodge representatives for a look at the proposed legislation and voice your opinion to them. The Al Koran Ceremonial will be held on October 27, hosted by Mansfield Shrine Club in Mansfield with a pork chop dinner to follow. All petitions MUST be in (with proper fees), read and balloted by our October 15 business meeting. The Divan has approved a one time petition fee of \$50 until December 31 to become a member of Al Koran, however the new candidate MUST attend our ceremonial in October, this petition fee will also cover 2019 dues for the new Noble. If you were made a Noble at one of our monthly cold sands you will be notified to be in attendance at this ceremonial.

Nobles, we all face hardships along the road of life and if you are facing those at this time and find yourself unable to pay dues please call us here at the office and speak to me, we can remit some portion of those dues and keep you in good standing, it only takes a phone call or note to my attention. The 2019 stickers will be mailed beginning in early October to those whose dues have been processed and are to be attached to the hard plastic card received in 2016, if you have lost your card please indicate it on the return statement and I will order a replacement. 
