



Fall is another time to prepare for winter and that dreaded word SNOW, make sure those snow throwers are working and you have enough melting salt, prepare your auto for those winter months with oil change, battery checks, wiper and fluid checks, you will be glad you did. Peg and I have just returned from some traveling to Daytona for the Imperial session, what a great time and the sessions were both enjoyable and a real learning experience, legislative changes will be presented when I receive the official notice from Imperial. We also traveled to Lake Geneva, Wisconsin with our son and his family a good time had by all except I had to lay a little low due to gallbladder surgery, but I feel so much better. I did not realize the problems that organ can cause to your system.

The by-laws section 332.2 require all members to pay annually the amount set by the Temple which at Al Koran is \$137.00 which includes your per-capita amount to Imperial and your hospital assessment going to the hospital fund in Tampa, if you have not paid your 2018 dues your statement will reflect \$274.00 total due. The dues amount MUST be paid before January 1 of each year; those who are in arrears for 2018 WILL BE SUSPENDED. You must keep your membership in your Blue Lodge in order to remain a member of any Shrine; you must also be current with your Al Koran dues to be active in ANY club or unit.

Nobles, we all face hardships along the road of life and if you are facing those at this time and find yourself unable to pay dues please call us here at the office and speak to me, we can remit some portion of those dues and keep you in good standing, it only takes a phone call or note to my attention.

We have 52 Nobles who have not paid 2018 dues. Nobles please speak to me for a solution to getting you current.
