Legion of Honor

Our next Legion of Honor meeting will be Monday, January 28 at 7PM. Location: St Matthews Church Hall, 9549 Highland Drive, Brecksville Ohio 44141. No meeting in December. We will meet in February on Monday, February 25 at 7PM, location to be determined.

In the September Meeting members in attendance voted to purchase an M-1 Garand rifle for the LOH Color Guard. Noble Louis Fow has purchased the rifle and has refinishing the stock. Our Legion of Honor is pursuing placement of a memorial monument at the National Veterans Western Reserve Cemetery to remember and honor Al Koran Veterans interned there. Howard Walker, Eric Butler and Mark Bollinger are assisting us with this project. Howard, Eric and Monica Johns a design artist have been to the cemetery to determine the process and specifications required to place a memorial monument. Our LOH unit has approved the design and placement of the monument. In January we plan to accept donations to complete funding of the memorial project. Presently we have pledges of \$11,500 towards the estimated total project of \$15,000. We plan to install the monument in June and organize a bus to transport Shriners, family and friends to the cemetery for the memorial ceremony.. Noble Robert Lijewski of Tripoli Shrine Center, Milwaukee Wisconsin commander of our GLSA LOH announced Tripoli Shrine Center will host the 44th meeting of the GLSA LOH August 14-17, 2019. Our 2018-2019 IALOH Commander, Ray Combs announced the 88th convention will be in Dayton Ohio, 17-21 April 2019. Adjutant Jack Conner PP has information on the IALOH 2019 convention in Dayton or you can visit their website. Since this convention is close to us we ask LOH members plan to attend with us. We look forward to increasing our attendance at the conventions in 2019 and continuing to increase our membership in our Legion of Honor. We will continue to look for ways to serve Al Koran and our veterans. We are recruiting for a color guard unit to march in Al Koran parades. If you may have interest in becoming a member of the color guard please respond to a member of the LOH. If you are not a veteran we will ask for LOH approval to make you an honorary member and instruct you in the required drill.
