Legion of Honor

Our next Legion of Honor meeting will be Monday, January 28 at 7PM. Location: Brecksville Masonic Lodge, 8922 Brecksville Road, Brecksville Ohio 44141. We will meet in February on Monday, February 25 at 7PM, location Brecksville Lodge.

We completed the first payment for the Al Koran Veterans Memorial Monument project of \$4,632 and remain in the process of approval with the Ohio Western Reserve National cemetery. Once we have approved the final drawing of the monument; our members authorized making the second payment of \$4,632. We have received contributions for \$13,345 or 91% of the \$15,000 required to fund the project. We continue requesting donations from individuals, clubs and units to secure the remaining \$1,655 to complete the project. We will organize a bus to take nobles and guest including veterans widows to the cemetery in June for the dedication of the monument. We are in discussions that may result in having a motorcycle escort lead our bus to the cemetery. It is our intention to request news media coverage. We also will invite our International and GLSA LOH Commanders. Our Potentate and Divan will help dedicate the monument. Please save the date to at-

tend, Saturday, June 15. The Legion of Honor unit color guard has agreed to participate in the dedication along with a bugler and bag piper. We are grateful and thank all who have donated to fund the project.

We are recruiting for a color guard unit to march in Al Koran parades. If you may have interest in becoming a member of the color guard please respond to a member of the LOH. If you are not a veteran we will ask for LOH approval to make you an honorary member and instruct you in the required drill. We welcome any noble whom may want to share some of their military collection with our unit; or to just attend and see what others are presenting. We continue our effort to sell our remaining Krag US Springfield model 1896 vintage rifles. A great opportunity for a collector. From the Recorder

Greetings Nobles,

As of this writing the winter has been great, not much bad weather but we will wait as the Weather Channel reported we are only 30% thru winter with another 70% to go, so you know what may be in store for us down the line. Peg and I hope all had a great holiday season and good times with family and friends. Our Installation of Officers is concluded and I congratulate all who were elected and appointed to serve Al Koran, I also would like to thank you Nobles for allowing me to serve as Recorder again in 2019, this is my sixth year and I have enjoyed every day especially meeting many Nobles who I did not know, Peg and I have been welcomed into many of the clubs and units when we attend and we will continue to attend as often as we can.

Nobles, there are still several who have not paid 2019 dues, please look at your plastic dues card and if you do not have 2019 sticker on it you have not paid your 2019 dues, if you are one of those please send payment NOW, you do not need your statement to pay your dues, they remain at \$137.00, you can send them to my attention in the office, please include your member number on check, if you wish to use credit card call the office so we can get that

info and process payment. The 2019 dues card stickers are being sent from Tampa and should be arriving to those who have paid their dues shortly, if you do not have a plastic card call me in the office and I can order a replacement, however we will need to charge for replacement cards. Al Koran does not have these cards; both these items were provided by Imperial to help all Shrine Centers save postage costs. There are 195 Shrine Centers in USA and over 300,000 members so it is a great effort to make sure the statements, cards and stickers are sent correctly and they rely on the Recorders to provide correct information. I have received several back via return mail which was sent to the address on file, if you have moved or are a snowbird, please inform me of your new address and also address of your winter months so communications are not lost, thank you in advance for complying. Tampa will be sending a reminder to those who have not paid their dues about mid-February.

As 2018 has concluded the annual reports were filed and some interesting facts about Al Koran. We started the 2018 year with 1,053 regular members and 4 associate members for total of 1,057 members. During 2018 we created 17, restored 11, affiliated 1

for a total of 29, however we lost 26 to suspension (NPD or pre-req. body suspension), 2 to demit, 1 associate dropped and 48 to death for total loss of 77, our membership as of December 31, 2018 is 1,005 regular and 4 associates for total of 1,009, our net loss was 48. Thanks to the hard work of our membership committee the net loss was better than previous years. Nobles please do your part to remain a member of Al Koran, if you are experiencing hardships please call the office and we will provide suggestions for dues payments, also be on the lookout for new members, petitions will be available on line. Requirements remain your potential member must be Master Mason in good standing and a resident of Ohio.

Please MAKE THE EFFORT to attend one meeting or event during 2019, you will be surprised of the changes, the officers have pledged to improve our meetings and events so come out and be part of the exciting 2019 Shrine year. Please call the office for all reservations. I look forward to working with all of you and the continuing challenges of this office.

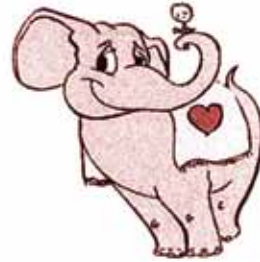

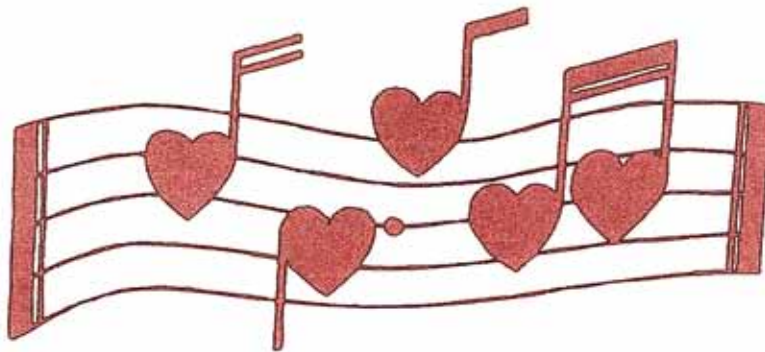
