Legion of Honor

Our next Legion of Honor meeting will be Monday, April 29 at 7PM. Location: Brecksville Masonic Lodge, 8922 Brecksville Road, Brecksville Ohio 44141. George Anders and I met on April 1 with Thomas Maynard the Assistant Director of the Ohio Western Reserve National Cemetery. We completed one new form indicating we are a veterans organization dedicated to supporting veterans and those currently serving. Thomas told us this may help with the national approval process as veterans organization requests are processed differently than charitable organizations. Approval at the national level is in process and we have tentatively selected a possible Al Koran Memorial Veterans Monument dedication date of Saturday, August 31. To hold this date we will need the National VA approval prior to end of May to allow construction of the monument and organizing the event which remains on hold at this time.

Planning however, continues to have Potentate Mark Bollinger leading the ceremony at the Cemetery with our Chaplin offering a prayer. IALOH Commander, Ray Combs hopes to be with us. LOH will present the colors. Russ Kilpatrick will play Amazing Grace on his Bag pipes and John Young will close the ceremony presenting taps with his bugle. We plan for the complete ceremony of dedication to take less than 1/2 hour. The Widow Sons will provide escort of the bus to the cemetery. We will stop at The Barn

Restaurant in Smithville Ohio for lunch on the way back from the cemetery. We are asking for news media coverage for this Al Koran event and plan to have both television and newspaper coverage. We are working with BRT Charter Service 7885 Snowville Road Brecksville, OH 44141 to organize a 55 passenger bus leaving Strongsville at 10AM and returning at 4PM. So far we have taken 18 reservations for the bus and the unit is asking \$15 per person for the round trip.. Please let us know if you will be riding on the bus? In total to date \$13,840 of donations have been received. We continue seeking donations for this project to reach our goal of \$15,000.

Lee Pilous has informed us there will be a 2019 Veterans Resource Event in Twinsburg and our LOH unit is planning to assist. We continue recruiting for a color guard unit to march in Al Koran parades. If you may have interest in becoming a member of the color guard please respond to a member of LOH. If you are not a veteran we will ask for LOH approval to make you an honorary member and instruct you in the required drill. We welcome any noble whom may want to share some of their military collection with our unit; or to just attend and see what others are presenting.

Also Erie SCH open house June 2 and Shriner Golf Event June 21 at West brook CC. GLSA LOH annual convention in Brookfield Wisconsin August 14-18.
