We continue to wait for VA approval of Al Koran's Memorial Veterans Monument with a tentative planned dedication date of Saturday, September 7. plans for the dedication include Potentate Mark Bollinger leading the ceremony at the Cemetery with our Chaplin offering a prayer. IALOH Commander, Eddie Daffern and Past Commander Ray Combs plan to be with us. LOH will present the colors. Russ Kilpatrick will play Amazing Grace on his Bag pipes and John Young will close the ceremony presenting taps with his bugle. We plan for the complete ceremony of dedication to take less than 1/2 hour. The Widow Sons will provide escort of the bus to the cemetery. We will stop at The Barn Restaurant in Smithville Ohio for lunch on the way back from the cemetery. We are asking for news media coverage for this Al Koran event and plan to have both television and newspaper coverage. We plan a 55 passenger bus leaving Strongsville at 10AM and returning at 4PM. So far
