





This doesn't affect the Hunters right now. This move will take a few months to get approved by Tampa. So for right now, there is no change on our meeting night or the time. Just a little trivia and history for those that would be interested. Did you know that the Hunters was started in 1953 and chartered in 1954. The functions of the group was to participate at Shrine Meetings, to promote harmony and to educate the members in game conservation and game laws. To raise funds for our Shrine kids and to help where ever the Potentate requests.

The first annual indoor Turkey and Ham Shoot and Miniature Sportsmen's Show was held on November7, 1954 at the Main Masonic Temple. In July of the same year (1954) the Hunters made their first Pilgrimage to Atlantic City, New Jersey. In May of 1955 the Hunters built the shooting range on the top floor of the Main Temple for guns and bow and arrows. Also in 1955 the Hunters went to the Great Lakes Ceremonial with their first ever float. From what I can find, there is no other Hunters group in the Shrine. The statement may be wrong so if anyone can disprove it, please bring it up at our meeting perhaps we could communicate with them. Just an add on and special note Norm Paynter, the father of Ill Al Paynter was not only a Divan member at the time, but one of the seven Nobles that instituted The Hunters.



Al Koran's April LOH meeting will be Monday, April 27 at 7PM, Brecksville Lodge, 8922 Brecksville Road Brecksville Ohio 44141. Invite a Veteran Brother Mason to attend. Tentative date for Al Koran's Veteran Memorial monument dedication is Saturday May 30, 2020 at Ohio Western Reserve National Cemetery.

Our unit is hosting an Arlington trip October 29 - November 1 where we will attend the wreath laying at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier. 
