2020 AL KORAN LOH ARLINGTON BUS TRIP

29 OCTOBER-01 NOVEMBER

INTERNATIONAL LEGION OF HONOR CONVENTION AND WREATH LAYING

COST OF THE BUS TICKET ROUND TRIP INCLUDING WREATH LAYING, TOUR OF THE WAR MEMORIALS AND GETTYSBURG NATONAL MILITARY PARK is **\$175 PER PERSON**. Since the IALOH business meeting is Thursday morning 29 October candidates and delegates need to arrive Wednesday night October 28. Some of us will fly in and ride the bus back. Where this is necessary the round-trip fare of \$175 per person will still be charged as the seats need to be reserved. Bus tickets must be paid by June 30 to reserve seats.

Hotel reservations using the IALOH reservation code should be made by individuals. Hotel rate for three nights including 13.5% tax should be total of \$441.

If attendees chose to register for the IALOH convention the fee is \$100 per person and covers hospitality room from 8:00 am to 10 PM.., Thursday night theme beach party, lunch Saturday following the Wreath laying and Dinner at the change of Command formal installation Saturday night. All other meals are the responsibility of attendees.

Hotel reservations should be made no later than September 1. Bus fare is due no later than June 30.

So, the total cost of the trip including bus, IALOH registration fees and hotel is expected to be \$991 per couple if you register for the IALOH convention. If you do not register for the convention cost per couple is \$791 with no hospitality room and all meals your responsibility.
