From the Recorder

I would like to thank the Nobility for their confidence in me, and re-electing me Recorder for Al Koran Shriners of Cleveland, Ohio. This has been a labor of love for me, but it is a little like owning a home, there is always something that needs taking care of.

As you may already know, Al Koran has not had a business manager in over a year, so all the work previously done by that person is now handled by the Recorder and the Treasurer, and we are both part time volunteers. As Recorder I have sent out over 135 Thank You letters, processed over 980 dues, processed hundreds of donations to the hospitals, paid the bills each month, and assisted with all of the 2021 functions of Al Koran. Our Treasurer, Jay Flack, has kept Al Koran in the black these last few years; he's done an outstanding job. Our "building fund", the proceeds from the sale of the property on Edgerton Road has increased by over 100%.

I have heard some grumbling about members paying their dues complaining about an assessment for the building, a building we no longer have. Nobles that portion of your dues was gobbled up by the per capita increase we had several years ago, we did not pass that increase on to you but subsidized it with the current rate of dues we have. Interesting fact we had more members in 1896 than we do today, and the initiation fee was about the same \$125, which is about \$4,000.00 and dues were \$50 which is about \$1600 today. You are getting quite a break.

Beware Nobles; there is another per capita increase on the horizon. Last year at Imperial Session, a \$20 increase in per capita (it was \$15, raised to \$30 several years ago) was narrowly defeated by the Nobility in attendance. I don't think that will happen this year, it is most likely to pass this coming July, and Al Koran cannot fund this potential increase as we did last time. Remember there are less than one thousand members of Al Koran, and if things continue to go as they have, we will be under 900 by the end of the new year.

While our funds have increased so have our costs. We have trimmed as many non essential costs as we can. Our income from dues is less than \$90,000.00. Nobles, that money just pays our bills, in fact, as it may pay the bills there are, often unexpected costs exceed the monies we take in. The monies in our investments are an investment in the future of Al Koran.

We are not the only Shrine Center experiencing such difficulties. There are a significant number of Centers in the same or worse shape than Al Koran. Membership growth in the Shrine has been international, although there are a good number of centers here in the US doing just fine.

Which brings me to Membership, I know, you hear this all the time, but it really is important. Please ask you sons, your grandsons, your nephews to join, and if they join, get them involved, then get out of their way. Let them experience for themselves what it is like to have fun and fellowship with others their own age, so that this wonderful institution and philanthropy will endure.

Enough with the doom and gloom, we should all be thankful for what we still have, and I am. Thus, I look forward to serving Al Koran and the Nobility in 2022; I wish you all good health, peace, and prosperity in the New Year. Happy New Year!
