From the Recorder

Welcome to 2022. Let us hope we can return to a more normal existence. Covid has had a detrimental effect upon Al Koran, as we have fewer and fewer events we are losing many members and participants to other activities. Many of the clubs and units are having tough times. We need to get back to fun and fellowship, and to be able to meet and gather in comfort and safety. As we are a social organization we need to socialize.

Dues have been coming in and 75% of you have paid your 2022 dues. If you are unsure of your status you can check it out on Webfez. If you feel that there is an error, please call the office or send me and e-mail. Please provide me with a date and means of payment, such as check or credit card. I do not want the numbers on your credit card just the date you paid. If you paid by check please make sure it has cleared at your financial institution. If you use a payment service please make sure that the information provided to that service is correct. I have received quite a few payments sent to Broadview Heights and to Brecksville. Beware Nobles; there is another per capita increase on the horizon. Last year at Imperial Session, a \$20 increase in per capita (it was \$15, it is currently \$30, and now they want to raise it to \$50.) was narrowly defeated by the Nobility in attendance. I don't think that will happen this year, it is most likely to pass this coming July, and Al Koran cannot subsidize this potential increase as we did last time. Remember there are less than 900 members of Al Koran, and if thing continue to go as they have we will be under 800 by the end of this year. I mentioned this last month and will continue to keep you updated.

We longer have a building of our own, but many are under the assumption that they are being charges a "Building assessment." You are not. But our costs of doing the business of Al Koran continue to increase and our income continues to decrease. If anything that "Building Assessment" (we no longer have), went to offset the last per capita increase, the one from \$15 to \$30.

To all our Total Life Members, you have all paid your life membership as well as purchased a life membership for per capita and hospital assessment. You will be receiving a letter from me soon. I just need to know if you are still with us. I have found information on many of you on the internet, but a few of you I can find no information at all on. I am trying to make sure the records of our membership are accurate.

Finally, the families of many of our deceased members have called regarding the magazine no longer being needed. I am working on it, bare with me.
