# Eva's Ride



Noble Roger Calkins had his niece contact Roger Neff PP, Chairman of Shriner's Children Erie's Board of Governor to see if Shriners could help her granddaughter Eva.

Eva, age 8, has a very rare genetic disorder. There currently is no cure for the 30 + cases in the U.S.. Though a Neuro Muscular disease similar to ones treated by Shriner's Hospitals for Children it was determined that Eva's current treatmentteam was where she needed to be. The disorder has taken Eva's eyesight in the past couple of years and deterioration of the muscles will follow. Make-a-Wish foundation has some specials plans for Eva later this summer.

Conversations with the family indicated that a special bicycle, one designed for sight impaired kids, could help Eva keep her core and leg muscles working for as long as possible. The Family had found a group in Baton Rouge, LA that could possibly help. Problem was ... there was a  $2-2\frac{1}{2}$  year waiting period.

Neff got involved, made the contacts with the foundation, had Eva's physical therapist help spec the bike and Eva's needs and then secured the funding through Al Koran Hunters.

Just two days short of three weeks time the Bike pieces were delivered to Neff's home. He assembled the bike and delivered the next day to Eva and her family in North Royalton. Joining Neff were Al Paynter PP and current Chief of the Hunter, Russ Arndt treasurer of the Hunters and Great Uncle Roger Calkins. Pink being her favorite color... so is the bike. Eva asked a lot of questions, and rode her bike a lot with different family members taking turns at guiding. A stationary stand was also purchased so Eva can continue her riding... rain, snow or shine.

The only ones happier than Eva and her family... were the Shriners present.
