offense) but it is not worth the time and effort if we only make one or two thousand dollars. I realize you may be on a fixed income and that one or two thousand sound like a lot, but it costs us over \$1000 each month to send out the newsletter.



DO YOU HAVE YOUR DIGITAL DUES CARD?

Can't find your dues card when you need it? Can't remember you member number or Shrine ID number? If you carry a smart phone you can now have your dues card with you whenever you have your phone with you. All you have to do is download the app My FezCard Viewer from the Apple store or Google play store. It's Free! All you need is you Shrine ID Number and your member number, which are available to you several ways. They are on your existing dues card, which is still good by the way, your dues notice, your WebFez record, or you can contact the office for that information. One of the nice features about your digital dues card is that when you pull it up on your phone, the color of the card will indicate whether your dues have been received and posted or not. A gold card (digital only, your plastic card will remain gold) means your dues have not been posted, a black card means you are a member in good standing. Go Digital. It's easy and quite handy.





A second donation of over \$1000 was made to the Shriners Children's Hospital Ohio for supplies for the Teddy Bear Clinics. This is an event for children and parents in the community. The children bring their favorite doll or teddy bear for a check-up. Our donation helped them purchase over 800 kits.





Our Court collected over \$1000 in donations of food and bedding, towels, medicines, and toys for the Cuyahoga Dog Shelter and pet food pantry in Valley View. They socialize the dogs and prepare them to become good citizens in their forever homes. The pet food pantry helps people struggling to feed themselves with a way to keep their pets rather than turning them into the shelter.

Our annual luncheon fundraiser had a new twist this year. It was held at the end of October and costumes were encouraged. Prizes for the best costumes were awarded. The food was catered by our own Lady Lois Riggleman, Associate Princess and her husband, Noble Marty Riggleman. Everyone had a wonderful time, and the food was amazing!

The Court is also preparing to host the 2024 Great Lakes Unit Meet (GLUM) being held September 26 – 28th, 2023.
