## **From the Recorder**

Once again it is dues season. Imperial sends out the notices, as they obtain a better bulk mailing rate than most Shrine Centers can get. However, your payments still come to Al Koran and I am the one who processes them. For those of you who have already received your dues notice, you will notice the \$20.00 increase. That is the \$20.00 increase in the per capita, passed this year at Imperial Session, which Al Koran pays for each of our members. Per capita is now \$50.00 per member; and Al Koran does not have the financial wherewithal to carry members for another year hoping they will pay their dues. Therefore, suspensions for non-payment of dues will take place at the end of the calendar year. Those Nobles who have not paid their 2023 dues have until December 31, 2023 to pay them, and hopefully you will pay 2024 also. Otherwise they will be suspended.

As of the writing of this article, I still have 42 Nobles outstanding for their 2023 Dues. I have e-mail, sent letters and made phone calls. Somewhat surprising, most of these 42 Nobles seem to fall into one of two categories; the elderly, those between 85 and 100 years old, and those around 45 years old. I can venture a guess as to why their dues are not paid. For our more senior members, they may not be in full control of their finances, and/or need to be judicious in their spending. For our relatively younger members, I would suggest that they do not value their membership in the same way as most of us do. I do not mean derogatory, but I am sure they have families, are working, and have limited time, and have not found a club or unit that holds their interest, and provides them with fun and fellowship. This last one is our fault.

Unlike the Grand Lodge of Ohio, Shriners' International does not remit the dues of any Noble for seniority. However, we have set aside limited funds to help those of you who are struggling with financial issues or poor health. We also understand that many of our senior members would like to remain Shriners but are unable to fully participate in Shrine events; we may be able to provide you with a reduction of your dues. Please, contact the office and let us know, we will probably be able to assist you with this. Contact information is listed below.

Shriners International has experienced positive growth in Membership for several months recently, this has not occurred in over 25 years. With your help we would like to maintain this growth.

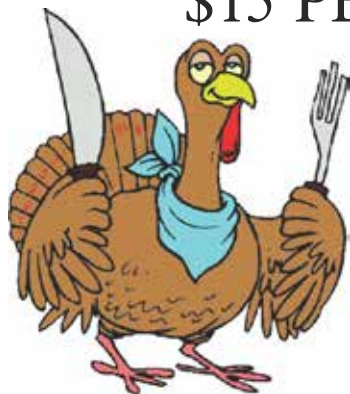
