Dear Nobles and Ladies,

I want to begin by thanking all those who have had me in their thoughts and prayers. To say the months of June and early July was particularly challenging for me health-wise is an understatement. However I am on the mend and am looking forward to getting back into the Potentate's role that you all deserve, visiting and taking part in all Club and Unit meetings and activities. I want to thank my Divan for filling in and carrying on while I was down and almost out. I want to thank Lady Melissa for never leaving my side, and always being there for me.

What happened: For a year now I have been challenged breathing, have been very tired all the time. Following testing my doctors discovered I had some blockage in a heart artery and needed to have a stent. If you receive a stent you also must go on a blood thinner for a year. A week following the stent placement the blood thinner caused three stomach ulcers that neither I nor my doctors were aware of to begin bleeding heavily, and the blood loss almost did me in. After several days in the ER, transference by ambulance to Columbus Riverside, and a couple of days of hospital admittance, they had it under control. I am currently very anemic and working on getting my blood count back where it should be.

With all that said, we are now into summer break but also parade and event season, and I plan to get out to as many of these as possible and invite all of you to do so as well. Coming up the end of July is the Mid-Ohio Shrine Club Annual Bike Show on the square in Mansfield July 27th. ## From the Recorder

Just back from Imperial Session and I must say it was one of the best run sessions in a long time. Business was taken care of in an efficient and comprehensive manner. The new patient ambassador stories will bring a tear to your eye, and withdraw money from your wallet. I am planning on providing the full promotional video's for your viewing at our October and November meetings, as we will be having our awards ceremony for our 25, 50, 60, and one 70 year award recipients in September.

As was usual, Membership was a large topic. While Shriners International is still declining in membership, we are closing the gap between losses and new members. New temples were approved for Australia and Paraguay, and the Lebanon and Bolivian Temples were presented their charters. Shriners are growing internationally at an astounding rate. With that growth, our hospitals also continue to grow. You are probably aware of our hospitals in Mexico and Canada, but we also have several clinics in Bolivia and Brazil, Panama, and Crete. Shriners Hospitals for children continues to grow and to prosper.

Last year we were able not only overcome the losses of 2022, but increase our endowment from \$8.8 Billion to \$9.7 Billion, that's right billion with a B. The budget to run all of our facilities was \$1.1 billion in 2023 and we actually realized a profit of over \$66 million. \$66 million is 6% of that \$1.1 billion. Would you be feeling comfortable if you had \$6 million, let alone \$66 million? Unfortunately, we are talking in billions these days.

Let's return to Al Koran. We also are getting some new candidates, but not enough to offset the black camel, and our suspensions for NPD. I have double to number of Noble I usually have at this time of year who have not paid their 2024 dues. Nobles we will not be carrying you into 2025 if you do not pay your dues for 2024.

As mentioned above awards night will be on Monday, September 16, 2024. I hope that's what I sent out in the letters to our awardees. It will take place at the Berea Masonic Center, 366 Eastland Road in Berea. With presentation of awards at 7 pm, with a dinner at 6 pm. Dinner is available with a reservation at a cost of \$15.

Nobles, the Shrine was founded on fun and fellowship, our philanthropy came later. Our philanthropy is doing fine; we need to increase the fun and fellowship. If you have an idea of something fun you would like to see occur, please let us know. What would be a lot of fun for you, and your family, may not be my cup of tea, but you can count on me to assist you in getting it going.


