From the Recorder

This will be your next to last hard copy of the Al Koran Newsletter. Starting in January it will be all electronic, unless you have let me know you still want a paper copy. There are many of you who receive the newsletter, for which I do not have an email address. I cannot send you the electronic version if you do not receive emails. The Newsletter is placed on the website alkoranshriners.com and you can always download a version from there, you can also print your own paper copy from there. The electronic delivery of your Newsletter will provide it you with a copy in full color and in a timelier manner. I just received my paper copy at my home, three weeks after the electronic version went out, and half way through the month of October, which was the featured month for Club and Unit events. 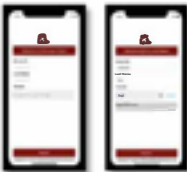

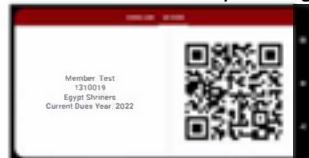

PROPOSED AL KORAN BYLAWS CHANGE

Michael J. Spisak, Potentate; Brandon Gould, Chief Rabban, James Barone, Assistant Rabban, and Terry Hamilton, PP; all of whom are Representatives of Al Koran Shriners, Middleburg Heights, OH, propose the following:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS Al Koran Shriners has requested that Article 3.1 of it's Bylaws be changed from:

3.1 Stated Meetings. A stated meeting shall be held on the third Monday of each month (except July and August). The exact hour of all meetings, including the annual meeting, shall be designated by the Potentate.

TO:

3.1 Stated Meetings. A stated meeting shall be held at least once per quarter on the third Monday of the month (except July and August). The exact hour of all meetings, including the annual meeting, shall be designated by the Potentate.

WHEREAS it appears that Al Koran Shriners has complied with § 324.1(a) of the bylaws of the Iowa Corporation; and

WHEREAS it appears to Shriners International that it would be in the best interest of the Order.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the proposal to change the frequency of Al Koran Shriner's stated meetings be approved, and that the charter of Al Koran Shriners be accordingly amended.

Effect of Resolution if Passed: Al Koran Shriners would have the ability to meet quarterly rather than monthly, and the charter would be amended to reflect the change in the minimum frequency of its stated meetings.

October 12th, 2024 was a special day for the city of Cleveland and the sailors and soldiers that served our country with such valor. It was the dedication of the Lone Sailor Statue at the Voinovich Bicentennial Park at the end of East 9th street downtown Cleveland.

The dedication coincided with the announcement that in September 2025 the harbor of Cleveland will be the site of the commissioning of the newest naval vessel, the USS Cleveland. The USS Cleveland (LCS-31) is a Freedom-class littoral combat ship. It will be the 4th Navy vessel named after our city.

The remarkable day's event, in large, was choreographed by Ill Tim Daley and Lady MJ. Tim & MJ registered participants, handed out American Flags to the flag bearers, and arranged the numerous groups attending for the ceremony, (herding patriotic cats). The flag bearers totaling 85 strong included Boy Scouts, ROTC Cadets, Young Naval Sea Cadets, Veterans from our Armed Forces, and Masons. With fez atop was Noble Frank McEvoy, Air Force & Legion of Honor and myself representing Al Koran and the Lorain County Shrine & Fire Brigade. 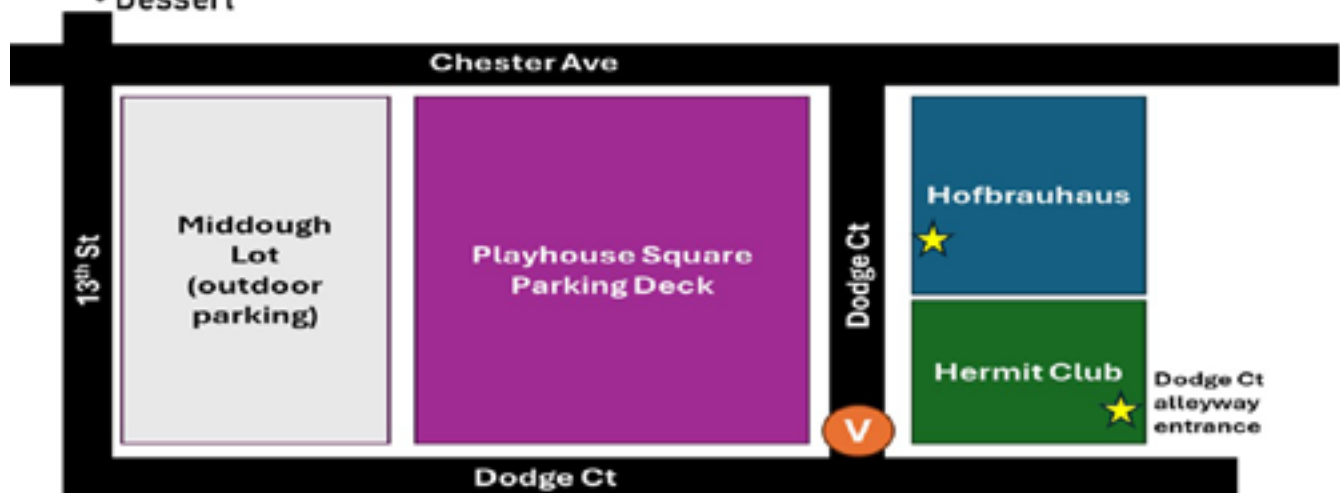

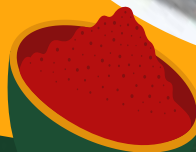
