OUR PHILANTHROPY.

I have just returned from Tampa where I had the wonderful opportunity to attend the Leadership seminar for all of our hospitals. I was able to attend as the secretary of the executive Board for our Erie facility. Also in attendance were most of the CEO's, CFO's, Directors, Managers, Medical Directors, and other vital staff members of our hospitals or Management team from Tampa.

Good news! This is the fourth year in a row that our philanthropy did not have to utilize any of the principle of our endowment to fund our hospitals, and our 2024 budget was \$1.1 billion. Utilizing third party payments, donations, and some income from the endowment we actually made money to put back into the endowment.

We saw over **300,000 children** from **108 different counties** at **130 contact points** around the world. The updated vision for the 2035 Vision is to triple that number by 2035.

We are improving our Research capabilities and also tripling the monies spent on research from \$30 million to \$90 million. Our research efforts are what made Shriners Hospital for Children what we are today; providers of world class care.







- 100% safe ice.
- Two inches of ice, please stay off.




