



Shole Donation

May Shole, the wife of Noble Wayne Shole, that we lost suddenly last spring, contacted Roger Neff about donating a boat Wayne had to the Shriners. Her wishes were that the boat be sold and proceeds be donated to our Children's Hospitals.

The Boat was a 40 year old, 25' Catalina sail boat, that had not been in the water for 11 years, in storage in Vermillion.

Neff agreed to what developed as a challenge. Making several trips to the boat to clean it up and get it ready to sell. This included the removal of 7 wasp nest and their occupants. Bob Stanley of the Mariners and Mike Brookins helped in determining a sale price.

Neff advertised the boat on Marketplace, spent several more trips to show the boat to prospective buyers and finally asked for final bids. The new owner came from Detroit. He was not the absolute top offer, but he was buying the boat for an organization that served Veterans and First Responders. SailorsGI, a 501C3, like our Hoapitals, teaches these Heros to maintain sail boats and learn to sail. It was felt the \$200 price difference was well worth it.

Neff helped the new owner prep the boat for the trailer ride back to Detroit. Delivered the check to May Shole, who in turn wrote a Check to Shriners Children's Erie and a check to Shriners Children's Ohio. Thanking Roger for his efforts she added an additional \$500 to each check. Thank you May for your Donation in Memory of Wayne.
