
A group of rooms have reserved at Marriott at the University of Dayton, but the discounted rate ends October 1. Click here here to RSVP today!

I look forward to celebrating with you on November 1!




First look at professional photos from DRTV video shoot!

The shoot also featured Hazel, Milli, and Everett. The final commercial will be ready by the end of the year, but we'll continue to share photos and video clips as they become available.
















Hundreds of families connect with SCO during Independence Day weekend
