
Patients and staff scare up a "ghouly" time at annual Halloween celebration

Patient Access wins Costume Contest



More than 250 people gathered at Carillon Historical Park to hear from Ohio Board of Governors Chairman John Bull, Administrator Randy White, Chief of Staff Dr. Sara Higginson, and from the Joint Board of Trustees Illustrious Sir's Ron Capps and Bill Rasner.

Nobles also heard from James, an Ohio burn survivor and star of a national Shriners Children's commercial, the father of Everett, a cleft lip patient, and former patient Adam who serves as a counselor for Camp Ytiliba. Each one shared how our care transformed their or their child's life.
