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RECORDER'S MESSAGE

Recorder's Message June 2026

It's off to the 152nd Imperial Session of Shriners International. And what is better than being in Tampa in mid-July. It looks like it will be a very interesting session.

Back to the business of Al Koran. My delinquent Nobles should have received a call from me in June. Remember, you will be assessed your 2027 dues on August first. Your 2027 are due by December 31, 2026.

Those of you who have not paid your 2026 dues by December 31, 2026, will be suspended for non-payment of dues on January 2, 2027.

So, how do you know your 2026 dues have been paid? The easiest way is to go on WebFez and look at your record. You will need to register if you haven't already, but it will tell you if you have or have not paid. If you are using the myfezviewer app, a gold card indicates that you are not paid up and a black card indicates that you are. Plus, you should have received a new plastic dues card, after your dues were paid.

Need help with your dues? Al Koran offers several programs to assist members with their dues, especially our senior members. Just contact the office and ask for the Recorder.

This is July, and the Sportsman's Raffle is in full swing, remember that this is Al Koran's largest fundraiser. We need to sell about 1350 tickets to break even on this event, it is imperative that we sell the remaining 1650 tickets. Doing so just might balance our budget, and a balance budget would go a long way to avoiding a dues increase.

Remember also that Imperial is looking to trim their costs for Imperial session, and if the cost trimming measures do not pass (and there are at least two on this year's call), they will seek a dues increase. They will seek that increase regardless of whether the cost trimming measures pass or not. The one on the current Call seeks a yearly increase tied to the cost-of-living index.

Please remember to look for the upcoming events on the website or in the newsletter and please use the website. We are trying to keep it up to date and informative. Your assistance would be greatly appreciated.

Finally, Thanks to all who assisted with the onions. They were especially sweet this year, and I have received a lot of good reports on their quality this year. Thanks especially to Scott Croxford for traveling with me to get them, and Bill Kemp for assisting in the unloading at the office. Thanks also to John Vaker and Barb Kutcka who together sold over 100 bags.
