RECORDER'S MESSAGE

The 152nd Imperial Session of Shriners International was a very interesting session.

The Nobility relinquished some of its control over Hospital business and allowed the joint Boards to act with approval of the Nobility regarding certain measures. This is a very interesting step. See my other article regarding this issue in this of the Al Koran newsletter.

Last month I mentioned that there was an item on the call regarding an increase in the per capita. Well, that item passed, so your 2027 dues will be going up. NOT what you pay to Al Koran, but the portion of our dues that goes to Imperial. It is all spelled out on your dues notice. Your \$157.00 includes; \$102.00 for Al Koran, \$55.00 for per capita (Imperial portion), and \$5.00 for the Hospitals. Well, there will now be an increase in your per capita each year from this point forward. The increase will be based on the CPI Consumer Price Index, essentially a cost-of-living increase. I believe our Assistant Recorder and Temple attorney has an article on this issue in this newsletter. **I just heard from Shriners International that this year's per capita increase will be \$4.00 making the total for your 2027 dues \$161.00.**

I still have 10 senior members and 17 other members who have not paid their 2026 dues. Those were due December 31, 2025. I have sent out emails, mailed letters, and made phone calls to these 27 members. Dues for 2027 will be assessed (by Imperial) on August 1, 2026. You will first receive a notice via email with hard copies being mailed out in early October.

Need help with your dues? Al Koran offers several programs to assist members with their dues, especially our senior members. Senior members, we just need to hear from you so we can plan to maintain you as a Shriner. Just contact the office and ask for the Recorder.

Please remember to look for the upcoming events on the website or in the newsletter and please use the website. Clubs and Units please get your announcements and meeting information into us so we can keep your information posted to the website relevant. We spend a lot of time making sure it is up to date and informative. Your assistance would be greatly appreciated.

Tickets for the Baldwin Wallace Lee Tressel Shrine Classic went out last month. Yes, there are some typo's in it. Yes, I noticed them about halfway through stuffing envelopes. No, I was not going to waste the time and money already spent to correct them. I'll do better next year.

Enjoy the Summer. It seems to be speeding up. Fall will be here all to soon.

THE FEZ & THE FINE PRINT

Greetings, fellow Nobles:

What a successful Imperial Shrine Session we just had! Tampa, Florida was beautiful and HOT. Our Oriental Guide, Frank McEvoy, was installed as International Commadore of the International Association of Shrine Yacht Clubs. Our Recorder, Tom Klecan, was installed as Third Vice-President of the Shrine Recorders Association International. Al Koran Shrine was recognized with the Gold Award as one of the only Shrine Temples in the world to have a net gain last year and Al Koran Shrine was recognized with the Membership Award for Conversion Excellence for having at least a 65% Master Mason conversion rate and at least ten new members. It was a banner week for Al Koran Shrine!

On the legislative front, several key pieces of legislation passed. First, there were several key pieces of legislation that passed involving the Colorado Corporation which governs the Shriners Hospitals. Dr. Leslie Stewart, the Chairman of the Board of Trustees gave a very detailed presentation explaining why the hospitals needed the proposed legislation to pass, in order to allow Shriners Hospitals to continue to provide services where our potential patients live and to adapt to the ever changing landscape in hospital care. All of the legislation that Dr. Stewart advocated for did, in fact, pass.

On the Fraternal side, other than some housekeeping issues, the big items that passed are that the per capita will rise each year by a factor calculated by our membership numbers and the CPI (Consumer Price Index) so that our per capita can keep pace with inflation without having to vote on legislation each year to raise it. The increase will be capped at \$5.00 per year. The other item that passed was to eliminate the \$20.00 per day meal per diem that each voting delegate had received at Imperial Sessions in the past. The one major piece of legislation that failed to pass was an attempt to eliminate reimbursement for spousal travel when attending an Imperial Session. Stay tuned on that one, because I have a feeling it will be brought up in future sessions. That bottom line is that Imperial is working very hard to make sure the Fraternal side has a balanced budget and that we can keep pace with rising costs and decreasing membership.

If anyone has any questions about any of the legislation, feel free to contact me and I will be happy to go into greater detail.
