As a 15-year President of the Fire Brigade, I have become the repository for the records of our unit. 2 huge binders worth if anyone would like some light reading. Within those binders are a wealth of information long forgotten. So, my charge is to share some of the morsels.

Did you know:

- Big Red is a 1953 La France Quad Empire 5 Man Cab Fire Truck.
- Purchased 12/2/1983 from the City of Avon Lake, at auction.
- Noble, Past Master of West Shore Lodge, and retired Avon Lake Fire Dept. Bill Morris was one of the last to drive Big Red while an active fire truck in Avon Lake.
- Purchase price \$3005.00 with a tax of \$150.25.
- 1984 each member of the Brigade was assessed \$100. to pay off the \$3000.00 loan.
- Many Nobles were involved but the Chief was Noble Bill Stebbins in 1983.
- In 2014 Red was appraised by A Cassic Car Appraisal Service, LLC for \$20,000.00 with Little Red coming in at \$1000.00. (I'm thinking alcohol might have been involved)
- Little Red came alive in 1986 when then Chief Ralph Hart, hand built our famous escort vehicle in his back yard.
